

STEPS TO BECOMING AN IPHM ACCREDITED THERAPIST

- 1. Complete the application form and submit payment (please note if your application was to be unsuccessful you would receive a full refund)
- 2. On submission of your application, you will receive an automatic response from us requesting the following:
- a) A copy of your relevant qualifications if applicable
- b) A copy of your public liability insurance if applicable (please note if you are not currently insured this will not stop us processing your application and once your application has been accepted you could claim a discount from one of our affiliate providers)
- c) A photo for your IPHM members ID badge.
- 3. Once you we have received this information from you we can then start to process your application. This will take aprox 7- 10 working days, unless you have made payment for priority in which case providing requested information has been submitted this will take up to 3 working days.

Standard Therapist Membership – Listing Only - You may list up to 6 therapies that you wish to have accredited and include your social media or website links.

Executive Therapist Membership – Includes full Profile Page - If you've chosen the Executive membership option, you may list up to 30 therapies that you wish to have accredited. You will be asked to fill out a Jot Form allowing you to customize your profile page. This will give you the chance to make your profile more individual and unique to you. The form will take a few moments to complete, but it will be worth it in the end, as you will have a fully personalized profile page that reflects your business and can be used as an alternative web page with its own unique URL.

Pre Requisites

You must possess the appropriate qualifications to practise the therapies you are offering to clients. This ensures that you are equipped with the necessary skills and knowledge to

deliver high-quality, safe treatments/consultations to your customers. Your qualifications should reflect the therapies you offer, providing a level of safety and trust between you and your clients.

If necessary, It is also important to ensure that your qualifications are regularly updated so that you are kept up to date with the latest techniques and best practices.
